4 SESSIONS

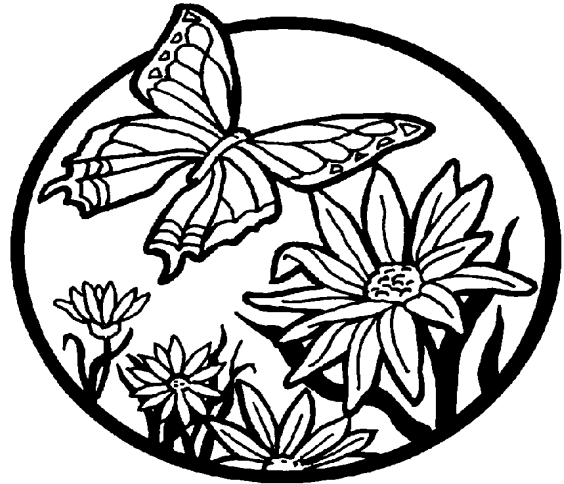
1st Starting at 9 am
